

ENROLMENT POLICY

ALBANY RESIDENTIAL COLLEGE

The Albany Residential College can accommodate 130 students. Vacancies arise each year and you are invited to apply.

All enrolments are at the discretion of the Board of Management and subject to a satisfactory interview.

Priority is given to isolated students who enrol at either Albany or North Albany Senior High School. A minimum of 12 places are reserved for students enrolled at St Joseph's College.

How Vacancies are Filled.

Subject to registration of your formal application by 31 January in the preceding year, (that is, 12 months in advance of the year of entry) vacancies will be filled in the following order of priority and within each category according to date of registration.

1. Isolated students who have siblings at the Residential College and who are enrolled at Albany or North Albany Senior High School.
2. Isolated students who are enrolled at Albany or North Albany Senior High School.
3. Isolated children who have siblings at the Residential College and who are enrolled at St Joseph's College.
4. Isolated children who are enrolled at St Joseph's College.

Following the 31 January in the preceding year, any vacancies will be allocated to other applicants according to date of registration.

The Residential College welcomes applications from non-isolated secondary school students, primary school students, and TAFE students of secondary school age.

Overseas students who gain admission to a local secondary school are welcome to apply for vacancies not taken up by Australian residents.

Please note: an "isolated" student is one who has deemed eligible to receive a boarding allowance under the *Assistance for Isolated Children Scheme, Youth Allowance* or *ABSTUDY*.
